Recovery Centers by Region:

Region 1:

[Kootenai Recovery Center](#) Located in Coeur d'Alene, The Kootenai Recovery Center provides free, peer based, recovery support, taking a non-clinical focus on recovery.

Region 2:

[Latah Recovery Center](#); Moscow, Idaho

Located in Moscow, the Latah Recovery Community Center, Inc. is a private, nonprofit organization serving people who are in recovery from alcohol and other drug use or mental health disorders.

Region 3:

[Port of Hope](#); Nampa, Idaho

Located in Nampa, Port of Hope offers intensive residential treatment, DUI evaluations, educational classes, individual/group counseling, intensive outpatient programs, and screenings and assessments.

Region 4:

[Northpoint Recovery Center](#); Boise, Idaho

Located in Boise, Northpoint Recovery Center offers an integrated care approach to treating addiction. They provide treatment for substance use, mental health conditions, and medical care needs.

Region 5:

[The Walker Center](#); Gooding, Idaho

Located in Gooding, The Walker Center offers rehabilitation for drug and alcohol dependencies via both inpatient treatment and outpatient treatment.

Region 6:

[Moonlight Mountain Recovery](#); Pocatello, Idaho

Located in Pocatello, Moonlight Mountain Recovery offers both drug and alcohol inpatient recovery services. Their treatments include: group therapy, individual therapy, assessments, discharge plan, cognitive behavioral therapy, dual diagnosis treatment, equine therapy, and a 12-step program.

Region 7:

[Stewards of Recovery](#); Idaho Falls, Idaho

Located in Idaho Falls, Stewards of Recovery provides substance abuse treatment. They offer assessments, intensive outpatient treatment, individual/group therapy, trauma focused treatment, relapse prevention, family support, case management, drug testing, and education classes.

Idaho's Behavioral Health Community Crisis Centers provide 24/7 services to adults experiencing a mental and/or substance use disorder crisis.
